

CENTRAL WALES BOYS' OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP 2019.

At Borth & Ynyslas Golf Club.

On Saturday 13th & Sunday 14th April 2019,

CONDITIONS

1. A competitor must be a person of amateur status as defined by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
2. No caddies permitted.
3. Each competitor will play 36 holes comprising 18 holes **On Saturday 13th & Sunday 14th April 2019**
4. Players shall start at the times laid down by the committee (Rule 6-3[a]). However, it is a condition of this Championship that, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rules 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole instead of disqualification.
5. The Boy's Committee reserves the right to set and/or alter starting times and to vary the conditions of the Championship if deemed necessary.
6. It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a ball, which is named, in the current R & A list of Conforming Golf Balls.

NOTE

Competitors are reminded that it contravenes the Rules of Golf for a player to ask advice from anyone, **(fore-caddies are not permitted in this Championship)**. The Championship Committee requests that parents, relatives and spectators keep their distance from play at all times. **Contact could cause disqualification.**

ENTRIES

7. Entries shall be made only on special entry forms.
8. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status and shall sign the declaration to that effect, contained in the entry form.
9. Entrants must be under 18 years of age on 1st January 2019.
10. Competitors must enter through the Secretary of their Home club who is to sign the declaration in the entry form, that to the best of his knowledge and belief, the entrant is eligible, and conforms in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status.
11. Entries limited to 66 competitors. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries from the highest handicap competitors shall be decided by ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries, for this purpose the exact handicap on the date of entry shall be used. All unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay thereafter, but will be given the opportunity to compete if scratching subsequently occurs.
12. Entrance fees will be destroyed the day before the event for entrants balloted out, who do not compete.
13. Gross and Net prizes for each 18 holes and 36 holes.
14. Measuring devices are allowed for distance only.
